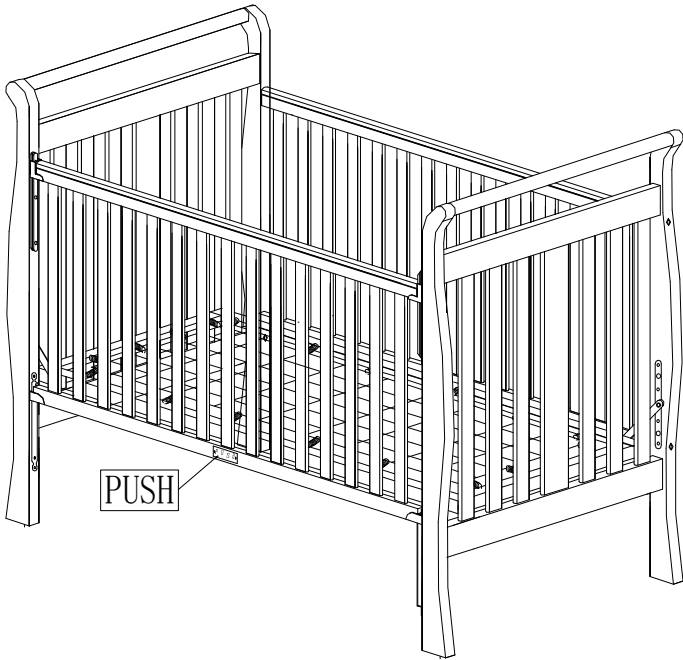

WARNING

- * Failure to follow these warnings and assembly instructions could result in serious injury or death.
- * Read all instructions before assembling crib. **KEEP INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE USE.**
- * Before each usage or assembly, inspect crib for damaged hardware, loose joints, missing parts or sharp edges, **DO NOT** use crib if any parts are missing or broken. Ask your dealer or write to our customer service representative (address & phone number shown above) for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. **DO NOT** substitute parts.
- * Infants can suffocate on soft bedding. Never add a pillow, comforter or padding.
- * When child is able to climb out or reaches the height of 35 inches (90 cm), the crib shall no longer be used.
- * To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.
- * **DO NOT** place crib near window where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.
- * Strings can cause strangulation! **DO NOT** place crib with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. **DO NOT** suspend strings over a crib or attach strings to toys.
- * To help prevent strangulation tighten all fasteners. A child can trap parts of the body or clothing on loose fasteners.
- * If refinishing, use a non-toxic finish specified for children's products.
- * When child is able to pull to standing position, set mattress to lowest position and remove bumper pads, large toys and other objects that could serve as steps for climbing out.
- * Never use plastic shipping bags or other plastic film as mattress covers because they can cause suffocation.
- * **DO NOT** use a water mattress with this crib.
- * Replace teething rail if damaged or loose (if teething rail is provided for this model).
- * **CAUTION: ANY MATTRESS USED IN THIS CRIB MUST BE AT LEAST 27-1/4 INCHES BY 51-5/8 INCHES (69CM BY 131CM) WITH A MINIMUM THICKNESS OF 4 INCHES (10CM) BUT NOT EXCEEDING 6 INCHES (15CM).**

- * Infants can suffocate in gaps between crib sides and a mattress that is too small.

WARNING ENTRAPMENT / STRANGULATION HAZARD:

- * Infants have died in toddler beds from entrapment and strangulation
- * **NEVER** use bed with children under 15 months.
- * **NEVER** place bed near windows where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.
- * The **TODDLER BED** or **DAY BED** is not intended for children under 15 months of age or over 50 pounds (22.7kg).
- * If guardrails are used as the mattress containment means, guardrail(s) provided must be used to avoid the formation of a gap between the mattress and the bed that could cause an entrapment (when product is used as a **TODDLER BED** or **DAY BED**).
- * **DO NOT** place **DAY BED** or **TODDLER BED** near windows where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.
- * **DO NOT** place items with a string, cord, or ribbon around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords.
- * **DO NOT** suspend strings over a **TODDLER BED** or **DAY BED** for any reason.

NOTES

- * Ensure all parts and components are present before beginning assembly.
- * Assemble on soft, smooth surface to prevent damage to product finish.
- * Phillips head screw driver is not included.
- * DO NOT use power tools.
- * CAUTION: Adult assembly required.
- * Assembly will require two people.



WARNING: Should this product become damaged, and/or components are broken or missing, DO NOT USE.

CARE AND CLEANING

Dust regularly with a soft, lint-free cloth to prevent soil build-up. A damp cloth may be used occasionally to clean surface. Dry immediately. Do not use any abrasives that may damage finish. Excessive exposure to sunlight and extreme changes in temperature and moisture can damage wood furniture.

If the crib is to be stored, store in cool dry place and carefully package all original hardware to protect from loss.









Check bolts/screws periodically and tighten them if necessary.

NOTE: PLEASE MAKE SURE THE TEETHING RAILS ON THE DROP SIDE (I) AND STATIONARY SIDE (H) ARE FACING UP.



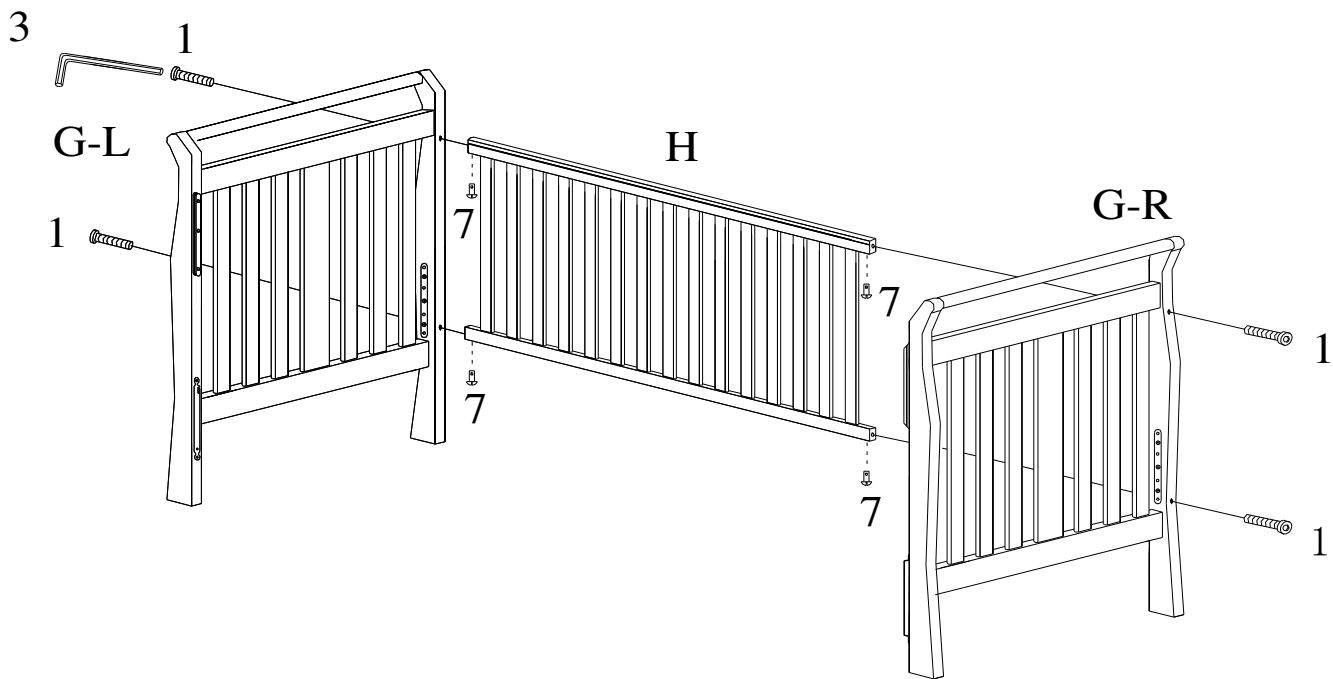
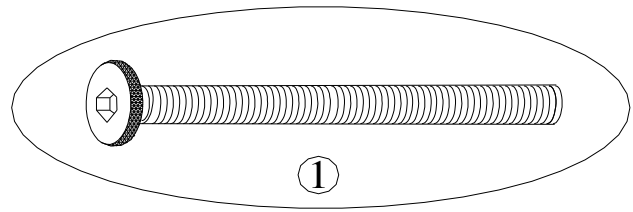
CRIB ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

NOTE: When inserting bolts, turn clockwise until tighten. Then loosen 1/2"-3/4" of a turn. After crib is completely assembled, return to each bolt and tighten. Use wax or soap on all bolts to facilitate assembly.

STEP 1

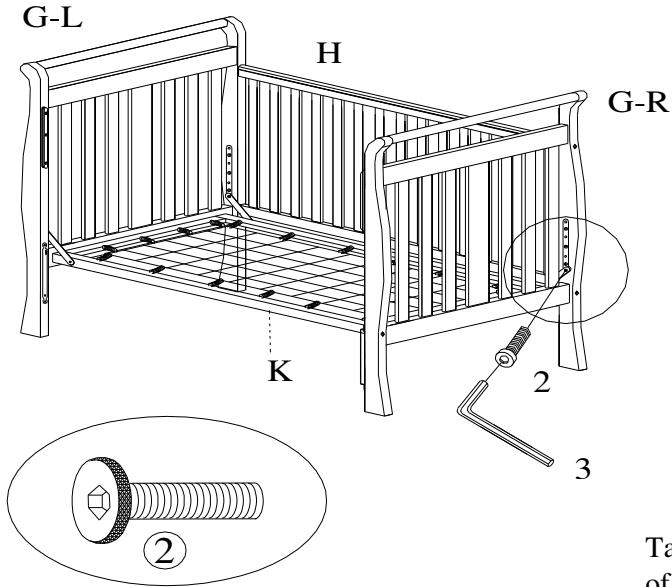
Attach left and right side frames (G-L) & (G-R) to stationary side (H) with hex socket head bolts (1) and barrel nut (7) . Use Allen key (3) to tighten hex socket head bolts.



3-IN-1 CONVERTIBLE SLEIGH CRIB WM1633-O

STEP 2

Attach mattress support (K) to the side frames (G-L) & (G-R) with 4 hex socket head bolts (2). Use Allen key (3) to tighten hex socket head bolts.



Raised edge should face down - this photo show mattress support is upside down

INCORRECT



Tabs on corners of mattress support should point up

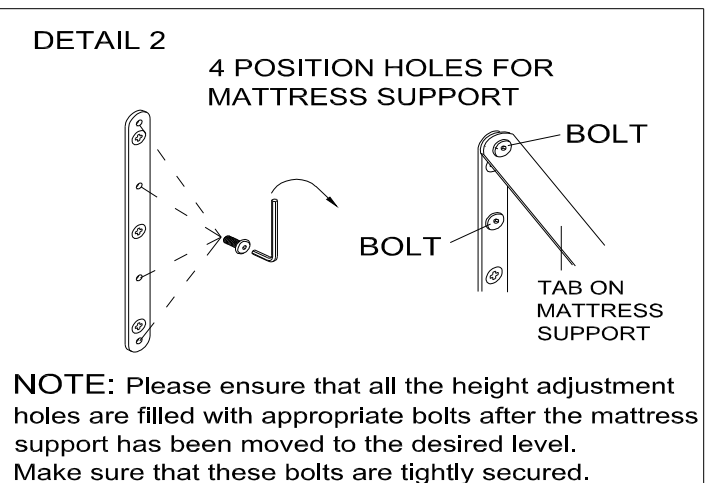
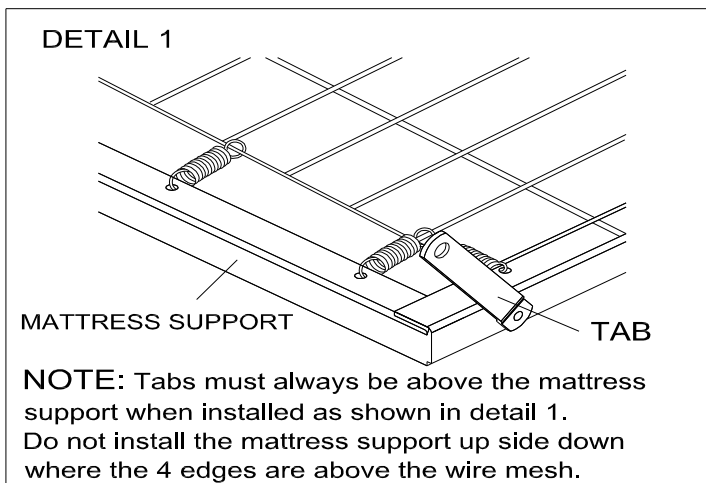


Tab to point up

Flat surface of mattress support to face up - mattress must sit on flat surface

CORRECT

Note: Ensure the flat side of the mattress support (K) is facing up.



3-IN-1 CONVERTIBLE SLEIGH CRIB WM1633-O

STEP 3

Align and slide drop side (I) from the bottom onto the drop side upper and lower tracks on the left and right front legs. Make sure the release latch on the lower guides (I) is to the outside of the lower drop side tracks (pull towards you). Raise drop side (I) until it is locked into place.

Caution: DO NOT force the drop side as you may break the locks, guides, or tracks. Attach rubber stoppers (4) before operating drop side.

AFTER DROP SIDE (I) IS INSTALLED ON THE TRACK AND IS LATCHED IN THE UP POSITION, INSERT THE BOLT (5) INTO THE RUBBER STOPPERS (4) AND THREAD INTO THE EMPTY HOLES NEAR BOTTOM ON LOWER TRACK ASSEMBLY (FACTORY MOUNTED).

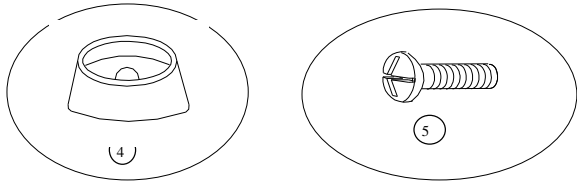
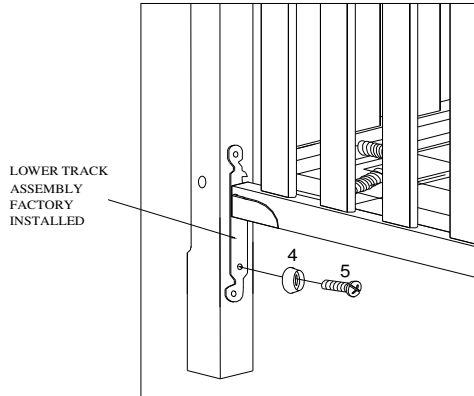
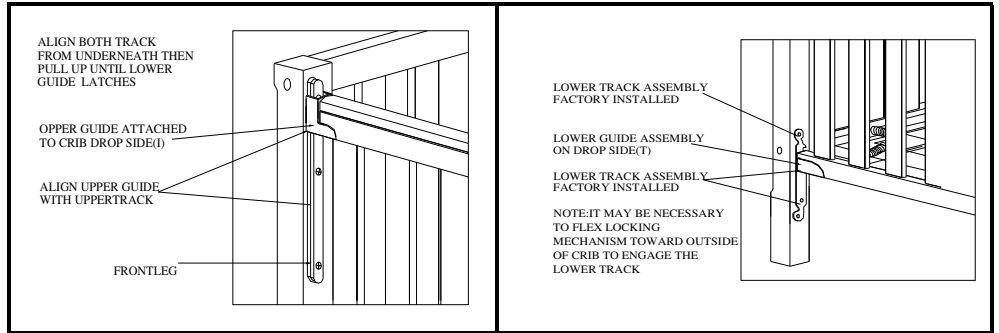

The release latch on the lower guides must be on the outside of the lower drop side tracks - pull towards you before sliding onto the track.

This rubber bumper must be installed prior to operating drop side - it will prevent drop side from falling to the floor.

NOTE: Photos A & B are to demonstrate how the drop side should be installed. The photos of the wood components of the crib may differ from the crib purchased and are for reference only.



OPERATING INSTRUCTION FOR DROP SIDE.

Stand at the middle of the drop side and hold the top rail with one hand.

Raise the drop side slightly to enable you to release the latch by pushing on the drop side lower rail with your knee. The drop side will now lower. Raise the drop side and it will automatically lock at the upper position.

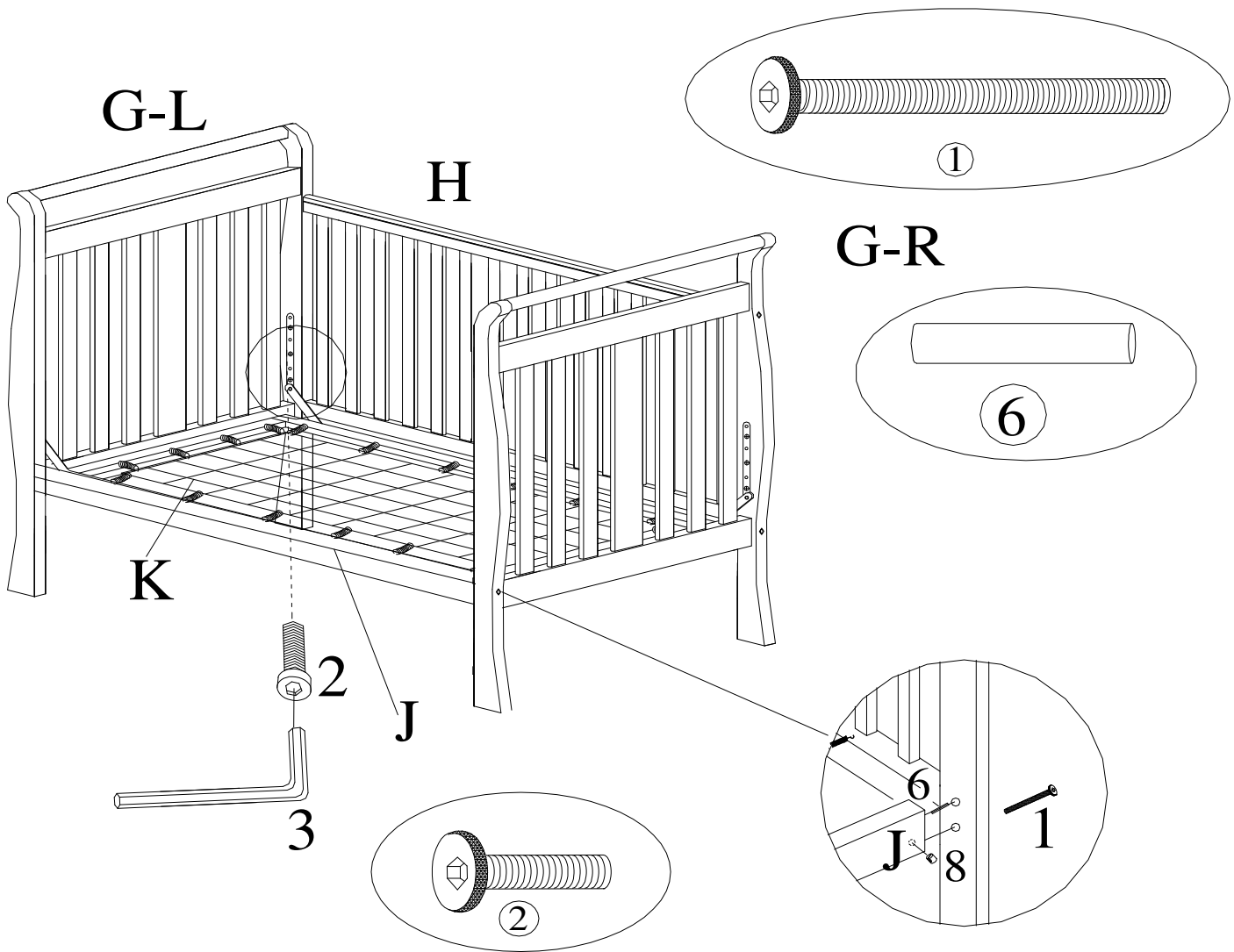
Always make sure drop side is properly secured.

Note: When assembling the drop side make sure the teething rail is on top.

TODDLER BED & DAY BED ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



TODDLER BED & DAY BED ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS: STARTING FROM CRIB

STEP 1 Unscrew the rubber stoppers (4) from the lower drop side track on the left (G-L) and right (G-R) front legs.

STEP 2 Detach the drop side (I) from the left and right legs by sliding the upper and lower guides on each end of the drop side down until they are below the upper and lower drop side track the drop side will fall to the floor.

STEP 3 Unscrew and detach the lower and upper drop side tracks from the left and right front legs.

STEP 4 If mattress support (K) is not in the lowest position, unscrew hex socket head bolts (2) from front and back legs and move to the lowest position.

STEP 5 Using the allen key (3) provided, attach guardrail (J) by using hex socket head bolts (1) and barrel nut (8) and gate pins (6) between the left and right legs (See details in DIAGRAM A).

STEP 6 Tighten all screws clockwise.

NOTE: When used as a day bed. The mattress support can be placed at any height desired.

TODDLER BED & DAY BED ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS: STARTING FROM SCRATCH

STEP 1: Follow step 1 to 3 of the crib assembly instruction.

STEP 2: Follow step 2 to 3 for the day bed assembly instruction located above (starting from crib).

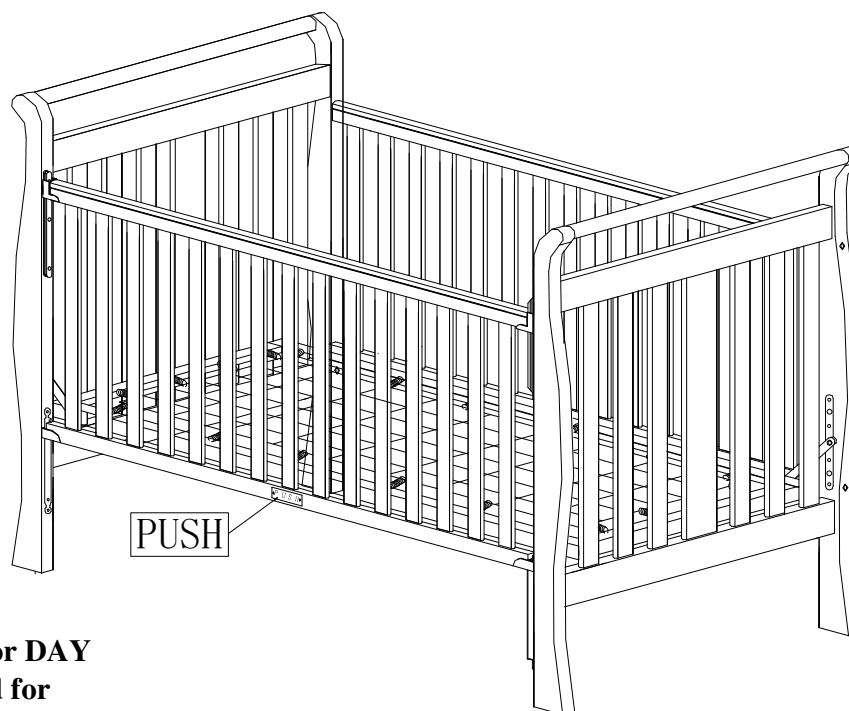

* **CAUTION:** Any mattress used in this crib must be at least 27-1/4 inches by 51-5/8 inches (69cm by 131cm) with a minimum thickness of 4 inches (10cm) but not exceeding 6 inches (15cm).

When child is able to climb out or reaches the height of 35 inches (90cm), the crib shall no longer be used.
